Joan Miró: Wall, Frieze, Mural; Joan Miró
Kunsthau Zurich; Galerie Gmurzynska.

Two exhibitions dedicated to the minimalist Spanish artist Joan Miró (1893-1983) are running simultaneously in Zurich. At the Kunsthau, "Wall, Frieze, Mural," includes works from across the artist's career, with a particular focus on his large-scale murals and installation pieces — the show centers around "Birds Taking Flight," a 1971-72 mural that is part of the museum's collection. Galerie Gmurzynska, meanwhile, has brought together about 20 works, focused largely on Miró's early output.
