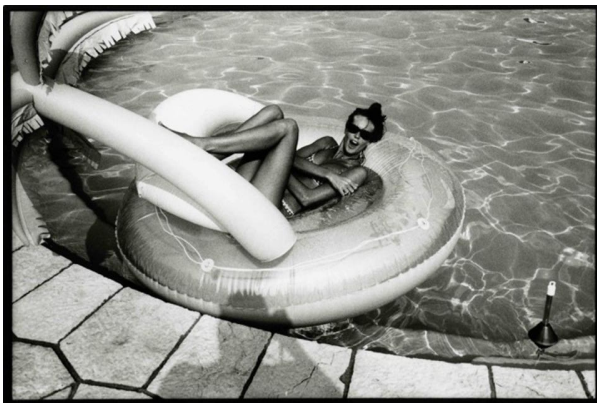
A Hot February in the Snow: The St. Moritz Winter Guide 2017

Gmurzynska's Pool Party in the Snow

Known for their extraordinary art events and collaborations, Galerie Gmurzynska brings the iconic photographer, Jean “Johnny” Pigozzi and his “Pool Party” to St. Moritz this winter. The solo show will feature over thirty black and white photographs as well as snapshots of Pigozzi's celebrations around the famous “blue pool” at Villa Dorane in Cap d'Antibes. The collection features shots from the 80s and 90s of friends such as Naomi Campbell, Sharon Stone, Elle Macpherson, Mick Jagger, Helmut Newton and Calvin Klein. Pigozzi, who developed a very sincere and intimate way of portraying his friends and companions, has a special way of letting the viewer feel the aliveness of his photographs. These images are sure to warm the hearts of art collectors in freezing St. Moritz this season. The exhibition will start February 19, 2017 and run through March 26, 2017 at Galerie Gmurzynska.
